Govt agrees to discussion on Op Sindoor in Houses

The government on Monday agreed to have a discussion on Operation Sindoor in the two Houses of Parliament, and it is likely to take place next week after Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi returns from his visits to the United Kingdom (UK) and Maldives.

Modi is scheduled to be in the UK on July 23-24 and in Maldives on July 25-26.

Indications that the government was prepared to have a discussion on Operation Sindoor came in the morning in the PM's customary remarks before the start of the session.

He described Parliament's monsoon session as a "Vijay Utsav" and expressed confidence that members of Parliament (MPs) would articulate this sentiment in one voice.

"This monsoon session is a very proud session for the country. It is like a 'Vijay Utsav' (celebration of victory) for the nation. The world witnessed the capability of armed forces. They achieved their targets 100 per cent," the PM said in a reference to Operation Sindoor. Alluding to

astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla becoming the first Indian to set foot on the facility, the PM said the Indian flag was recently unfurled at the International Space Station. He also spoke of the "shrinking footprint of Naxalism" and that the red zone was turning into a green-growth zone, which, he said, was evidence that the Constitution was prevailing over bombs and guns.

Modi spoke of the bountiful monsoon helping economic activities. He said water reservoir levels had trebled in the past 10 years, which would benefit the economy. The PM said prior to 2014, India grappled with double-digit inflation. "Today, with inflation rates hovering around 2 per cent, citizens are experiencing relief and improved ease of living. Low inflation, coupled with high growth, reflects

a strong and steady development journey," he said.

Parties in the INDIA bloc have demanded the PM address Parliament on Operation Sindoor and also clarify American President Donald Trump's claims that he got India and Pakistan to end hostilities. In his pre-session remarks Modi lauded the multiparty delegations, which comprised MPs from different parties, which visited various parts of the world to convey India's position post-Operation Sindoor.

Later in the day, at a meeting of the Business Advisory Committee (BAC) of the Lok Sabha, government representatives noted the PM was going abroad this week, and a debate on Operation Sindoor would take place when he was present in the House next week. Some Opposition members also called for a debate on the Special Intensive Revision of electoral rolls in Bihar and the situation in Manipur.

Process for removal of Justice Varma set rolling

The process for the removal of Justice Yashwant Varma was set in motion on Monday with parliamentarians submitting notices to the presiding officers of the Lok Sabha and the Rajya Sabha.

While the notice submitted to the Rajya Sabha Chairman had signatures of 63 opposition members, the one submitted to the Lok Sabha Speaker was a bipartisan effort with 152 members, including Leader of the Opposition Rahul Gandhi, supporting the move.

Both Houses, sources said, may accept the motions on Tuesday, and their Chairs are likely to jointly initiate formalities for the constitution of an enquiry committee according to the Judges (Inquiry) Act.

The Act states that no inquiry committee shall be constituted unless the motion has been admitted in both Houses. PTI

Govt seeks inputs from states, central ministries on 8th pay commission



The government has sought inputs from major stakeholders, including the Defence and Home ministries, the Department of Personnel and Training, as well as states, on setting up the 8th Central Pay Commission, Parliament was informed on Monday.

In January, the Cabinet approved setting up the 8th Pay Commission to revise salaries of nearly 5 million central government employees and allowances of about 6.5 million pensioners. To a question on the reasons for not setting up the Commission even after six months, Minister of Finance Pankaj Chaudhary said: "Inputs have been sought from major stakeholders, including Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Home Affairs, Department of Personnel & Training and from States."

The Chairperson and members of the 8th CPC will be appointed once the 8th Central Pay Commission is notified by the government, Chaudhary said in a written reply to the Lok Sabha. PTI

340 mn got jobs since 2014 in MSMEs: Minister

More than 34 million people have got jobs since 2014 in micro and medium enterprises through the Udyam and Udyam Assist portals, Union Minister Jitan Ram Manjhi informed the Rajya Sabha on Monday. The Minister of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises gave the information while responding to supplementaries.

He said there is no dearth of money, and small workers are getting financial assistance under various schemes. For Instance, he said, under the PM Vishwakarma Yojna, people such as cobblers and salon workers have received money. PTI

DAE exploring rare-earth group elements in potential areas: Reddy

The exploration of rare earth group elements in many potential geological areas in the country is being carried out by a unit of the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), the Parliament was informed on Monday. Replying to a question in Rajya Sabha, coal and mines minister G Kishan Reddy said, "Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research (AMD), a constituent unit of Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), is carrying out exploration and augmentation of rare earth group elements along coastal/ inland/ riverine placer sands, as well as in hard rock terrains in several potential geological domains in the country." DGCA, BCAS, AAI have 4,291 vacant posts; operations not impacted: Govt

As many as 4,291 positions are lying vacant at aviation regulators DGCA and BCAS as well as at state-owned Airports Authority of India but the shortfall has not impacted the functioning of these organisations, the government said on Monday. Many posts were also created in recent times at the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA), Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS) and AAI. Nearly 50 per cent or 823 sanctioned positions at DGCA are lying vacant while 441 posts, including 426 technical positions, were created between 2022 and 2024, raising the total technical posts at the regulator to 1,063, as per the official data. In 2024, 84 operational posts were created during restructuring of BCAS, Minister of State for Civil Aviation Murlidhar Mohol told the Rajya Sabha. BS REPORTER

MoE in process of drafting Bill for higher education body

The Ministry of Education is in the process of drafting a bill for establishing a higher education commission of India (HECI), proposed as a unified higher education regulatory body, the Lok Sabha was informed on Monday. Union Minister of State for Education Sukanta Majumdar shared the information in a written reply to a question. "The National Education Policy 2020 envisions a 'light but tight' regulatory framework to ensure integrity, transparency and resource efficiency of the educational system through audit and public disclosure while encouraging innovation and out-of-the-box ideas," Majumdar said. PTI

Bill to simplify framework for shipping documents passed

Parliament passed The Bills of Lading Bill, 2025 that aims to update and simplify the legal framework for shipping documents. The Bills of Lading Bill 2025, which was passed by the Lok Sabha this year, was passed in the Rajya Sabha by a voice vote in the absence of the Congress who staged a walkout in the post-lunch session. Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways Sarbananda Sonowal moved the bill for consideration and passage by the Upper House. The minister said India's maritime trade, because of its significant contribution to the country's economy, is a harbinger of "our economic growth and prosperity as a nation" PTI

OBITUARY | VELIKKAKATHU SANKARAN ACHUTHANANDAN (1923-2025)

VS, the quintessential comrade

Former Kerala chief minister and veteran CPI (M) leader Velikkakathu Sankaran Achuthanandan passed away in Thiruvananthapuram on Monday due to prolonged illness. He was 101.

Achuthanandan was admitted to SUT Hospital in Thiruvananthapuram for more than a month. His body will be taken to Alappuzha on Tuesday, and the funeral will be held at Valiya Chudukadu burial ground on Wednesday. He is survived by his wife, K Vasumathy, and their two children, daughter V V Asha and son V A Arun Kumar.

Achuthanandan, who was popularly known by his initials VS, was one of the last founding members of the party, and the state's chief minister from 2006 to 2011.

He was part of the CPM Politburo from 1985 to 2009, and was in the party's central committee after that. Achuthanandan is also credited to be the longest-serving leader of opposition in the history of the Kerala assembly, being in

the position for around 15 years. He was elected to the Kerala assembly for seven terms.

Achuthanandan was born into a family of agricultural workers in Punnapra, Alappuzha, in 1923. He spearheaded various struggles in Kerala for the last eight decades- starting from organising coir factory workers, toddy tappers, and agricultural labourers in his initial years. His first brush with the trade union movement was when he organised the coir workers at the Aspinwall Company, where he had started working.

He joined the Communist Party in

1940 at the age of 17, after beginning his political journey through trade union activities and the State Congress in 1939. He was instrumental in founding the Travancore Karshaka Thozhilali Union, which later became the Kerala State Karshaka Thozhilali Union.

Achuthanandan also played a crucial role in uplifting agricultural workers in Kuttanad, who were subjected to terrible exploitation by landlords. During the Punnapra-Vayalar uprising against the Diwan of Travancore, he was arrested and subjected to severe custodial torture.

"As a public speaker, VS had mastered the art of communicating directly with the audience. Known for his austere lifestyle and unwavering commitment to social justice, Achuthanandan has left an indelible mark on Kerala politics. In his death, the party and the communist movement have suffered a grievous loss," CPM said in a statement. He was admired across party lines for the role he played as the leader of the Opposition between 2001 and 2006.
